# Mirove Square

Feilden+Mawson Prague (FAM Architekti) have won an open architectural competition to regenerate Mirove Square in Dobris, a town south of Prague.

Mirove Square is the main public square in Dobris and, although at the heart of the town, it is a soulless place dominated by heavy traffic. Our winning design scheme improves all the essential functional elements of the square and gives clarity to their arrangement. The existing traffic-dominated town centre will be transformed, with the central area of the square defined as a quiet communal space in a predominantly pedestrian area.
