## International architectural competition - 1st place

Feilden+Mawson's winning design scheme for new university buildings in a run-down city centre will create a new urban vision for the site, which will house the Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Architecture and Centre for Education and Consultancy.

The proposal includes a new urban landscaped space, framed by two existing listed 1880's buildings and shaped by new extensions. The main design criteria were economy and general flexibility of academic spaces. This has been achieved by a careful designation of use within internal defined zones and the relationship between the new and existing buildings which precludes the need for expensive glazed atria or lightwells. The use of copper perforated panels on the new buildings will reflect light and enhance the feeling of nature within the urban context created by the new garden.
