UK Supreme Court

The United Kingdom Supreme Court was created by the Constitutional Reform Act to replace the Law Lords Appellate Committee in the Palace of Westminster.

Feilden+Mawson were appointed as architects and technical advisors to implement the renovation of Middlesex Guildhall on Parliament Square as the United Kingdom Supreme Court and also to house the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council.

The scheme received Planning and Listed Building Consent in November 2006, validated at Judicial Review in March 2007. Kier Group were appointed, through a PDS, as contractors in June 2007 and the UKSC is expected to open in October 2009.
